This strong emphasis on information literacy and libraries is what makes LearningLib.org unique.

Every year the platform develops with new functions or tools to enhance user experience and to make it more flexible to publish resources.

LearningLib.org have a major focus on Creative Commons Licenses and requirements of OER these years (Discover more: <u>Open Educational Resources at the Royal Danish</u> <u>Library</u>)

The consortium is open to more collaborators.

A primary focus of LearningLib.org has been to transform the culture of sharing teaching materials and resources from a closed system to an open one.

The consortium and network surrounding LearningLib.org have served as ambassadors for this initiative.

Each year, content is reviewed, and creators are contacted if any resources need to be updated.

A more thorough peer review process for resources is being considered as the platform grows.



LearningLib.org: Content

LearningLib.org is build in Wordpress and with an integration to H5P.

H5P gives the user a lot of opportunity to make interactive elements.

Learning resources are published as soon as the creator believes they are ready. This makes the use flexible.

Find resources such as quizzes on copyright, videos on how to search for legal documents, steps for conducting a systematic review, a paper fortune teller about Generative Al etc.


